• Fashion Design

Styling/Pattern Cutting and Fashion Accessories

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd years: Styling, Pattern Cutting and Accessories (millinery, shoes, jewellery, fine leather goods). This training program permits you to acquire the creativity and know-how essential for the young collection designer.
- Fashion accessories: a single training program: hats, jewellery and fine leather goods.
- French Fashion Design: English-language program in fashion design.
- DU in Fashion, Luxury products and Art of living, concentration in design and creation, a degree program taught in French and equivalent to a one-year master in a French university.

• Fashion Management

Training for careers in the fashion and textiles and clothing industries, from fashion buyer to product manager.

After high school

- Mod'Art Management: 3 years in Paris followed by 1 year in England, Bachelors diploma (honours) in Fashion Management and Textiles or French University diploma (DU) «Fashion, Luxury products and Art of living», 4 years

After 2 years of post-secondary studies

- Program Mode & Business: 2 years: 1 year in France followed by 1 year in a British university. BA (Hons) in Fashion Management and Textile.
- The program Mode and Business: 2 years: 1 year in Paris (fashion management) followed by the European program of seminars in the European fashion capitals and work placements, DU Luxate and Art of living.

After 3 years of post-secondary studies

- Fashion, Luxury Products and Art of Living program (university diploma) : Masters level 1 (4 years post-secondary): a series of specialised one-week seminars in the European fashion capitals, an intensive "fashion products" training program organised around related in-company placements.
- The program «Post graduate Diploma», english program in Fashion Management, equivalent Master 1.

After 4 years of post-secondary studies

- Program MBA in Economy and Management specialised in Luxury goods and Fashion Industries (Master2) : pioneering program leading to a French university diploma, conducted in English. TOEFL score of 76/80 iBT(or equivalent) required.

International partners of Mod'art gives students the opportunity to obtain university diplomas:

- Bachelors (Honours) in Fashion Management and Textiles (4 years post-secondary) at either the London College of Fashion, Nottingham Trent University. This diploma gives access to university Masters programs (MBA, MA).
- MBA, specialization in Fashion, Luxury Products and Art of Living (Master 2) in partnership with the Université de Perpignan. Courses are conducted in English.

Strengths
